

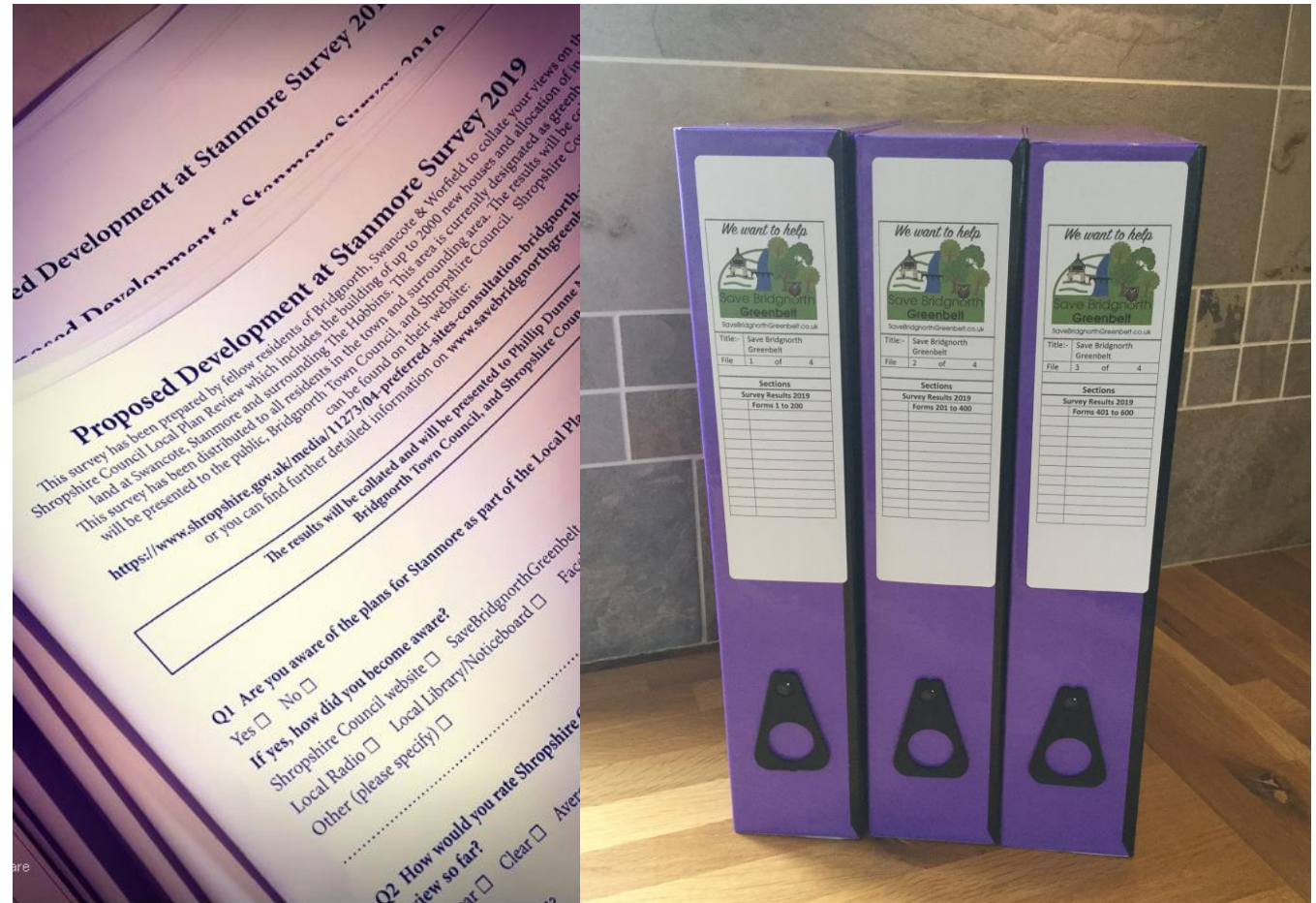

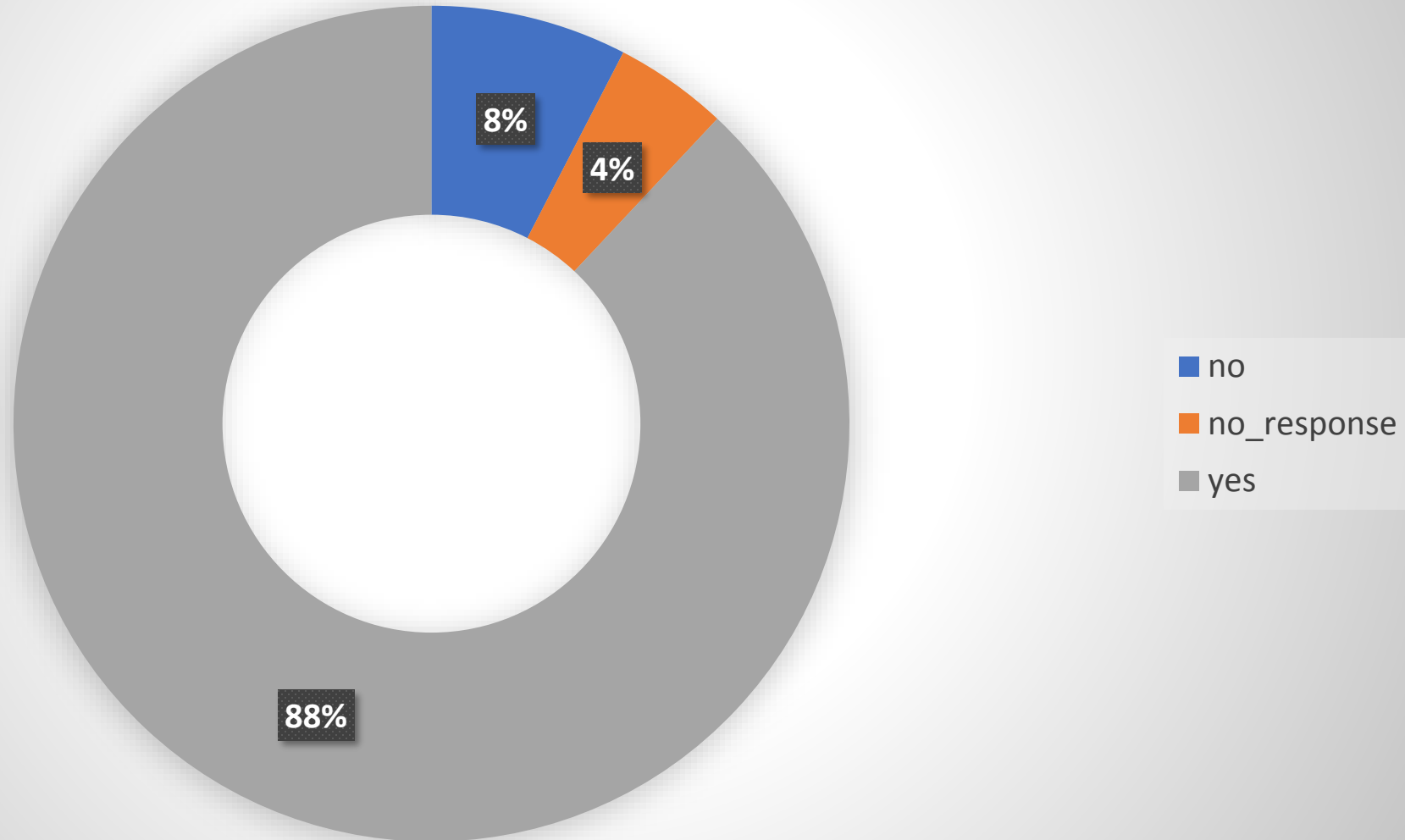
Survey Results 2019

- Shared at 2 public meetings circa 500 residents

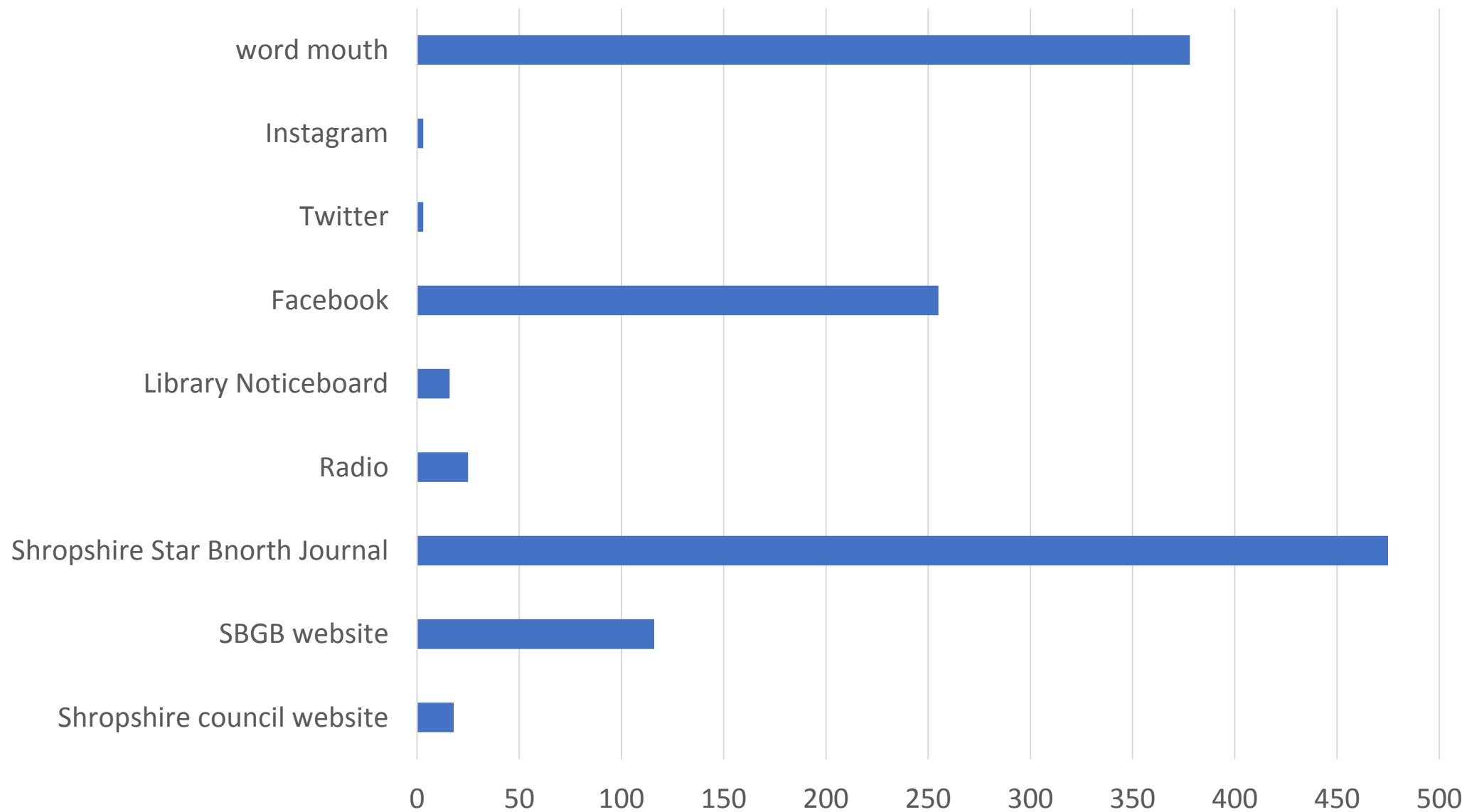


Q1) Are you aware of the plans for Stanmore as part of the Local Plan Review 2018 Bridgnorth ?

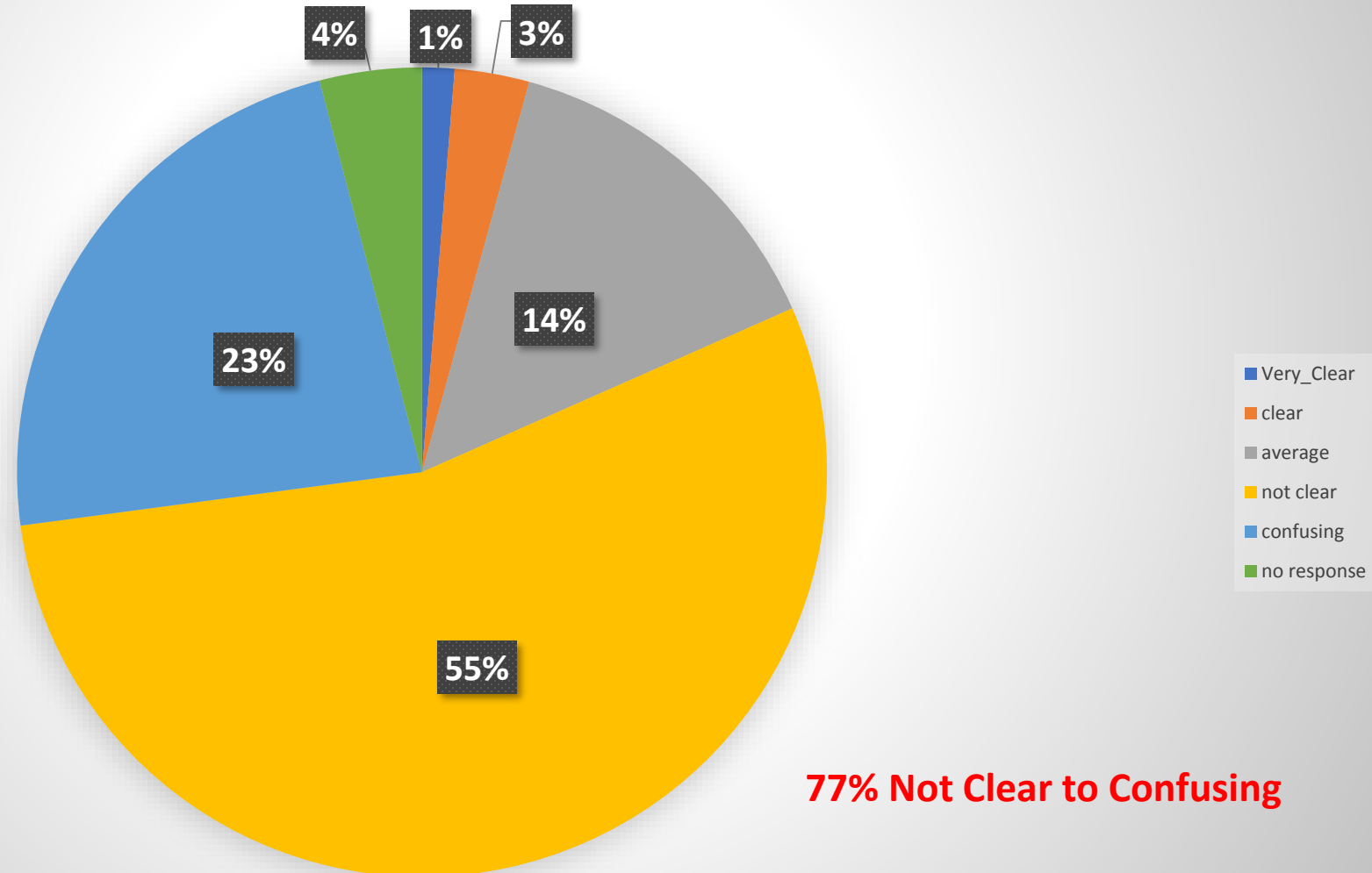




Q1a) If yes how did you become aware?

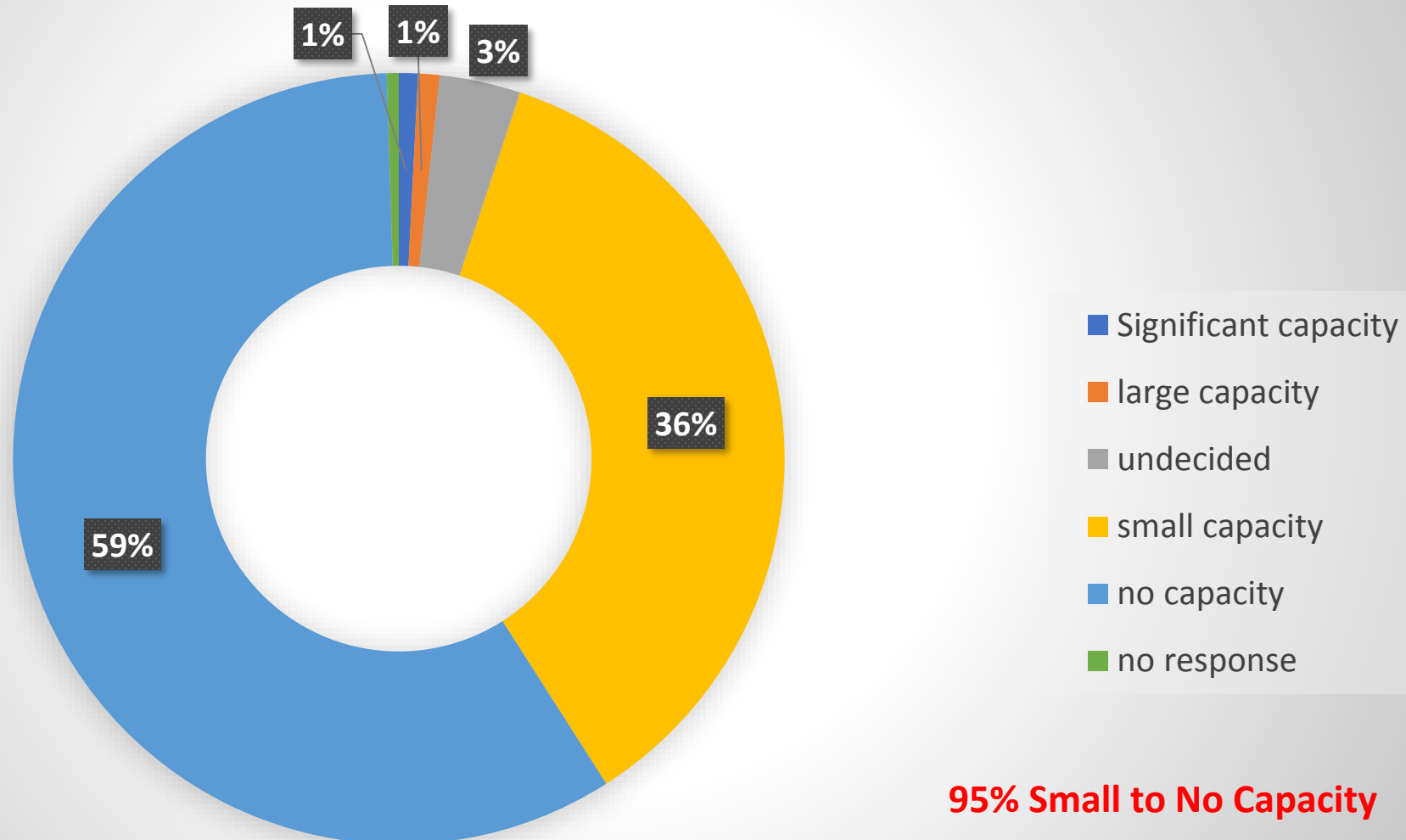


How would you rate Shropshire Council's communication of the scale and detail of the Bridgnorth Local Plan Review so far ?



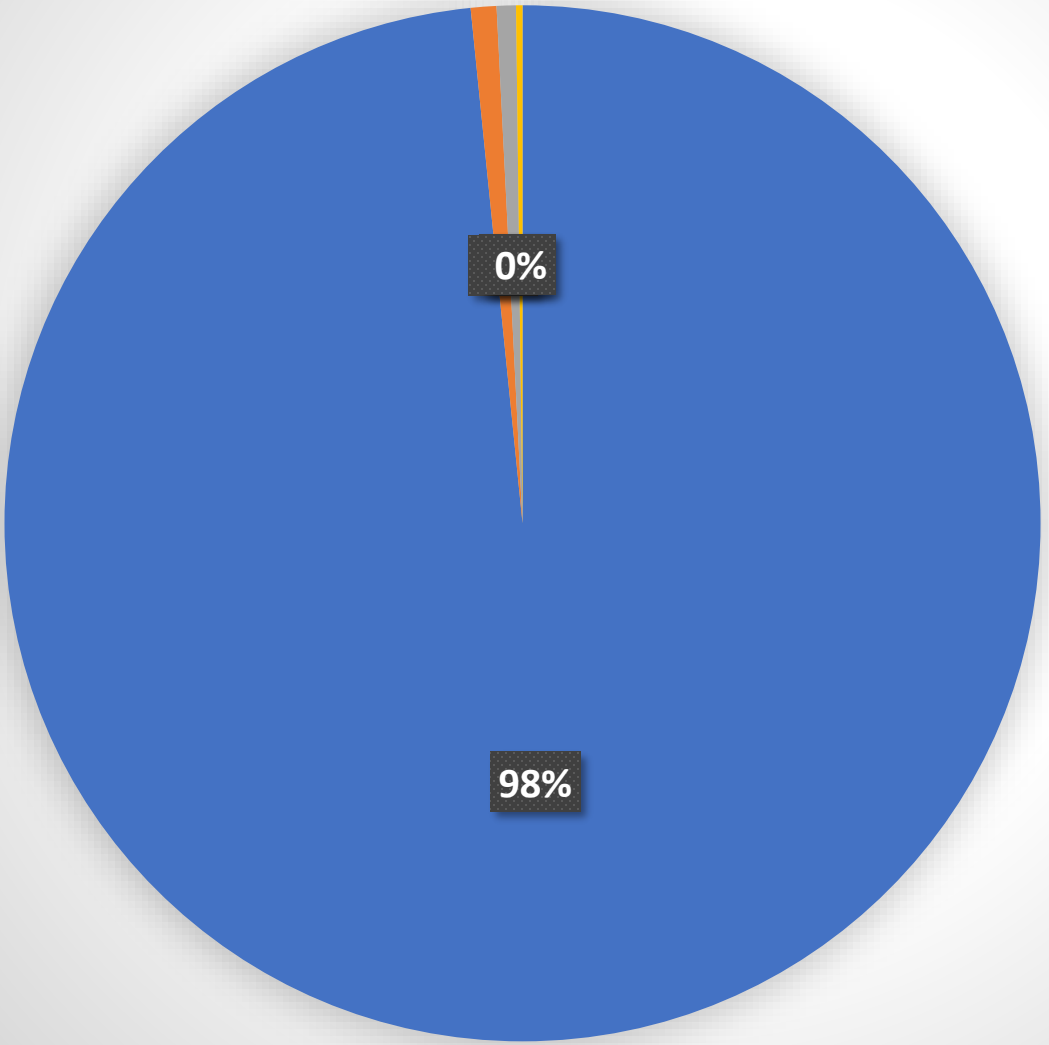

95% Small to No Capacity

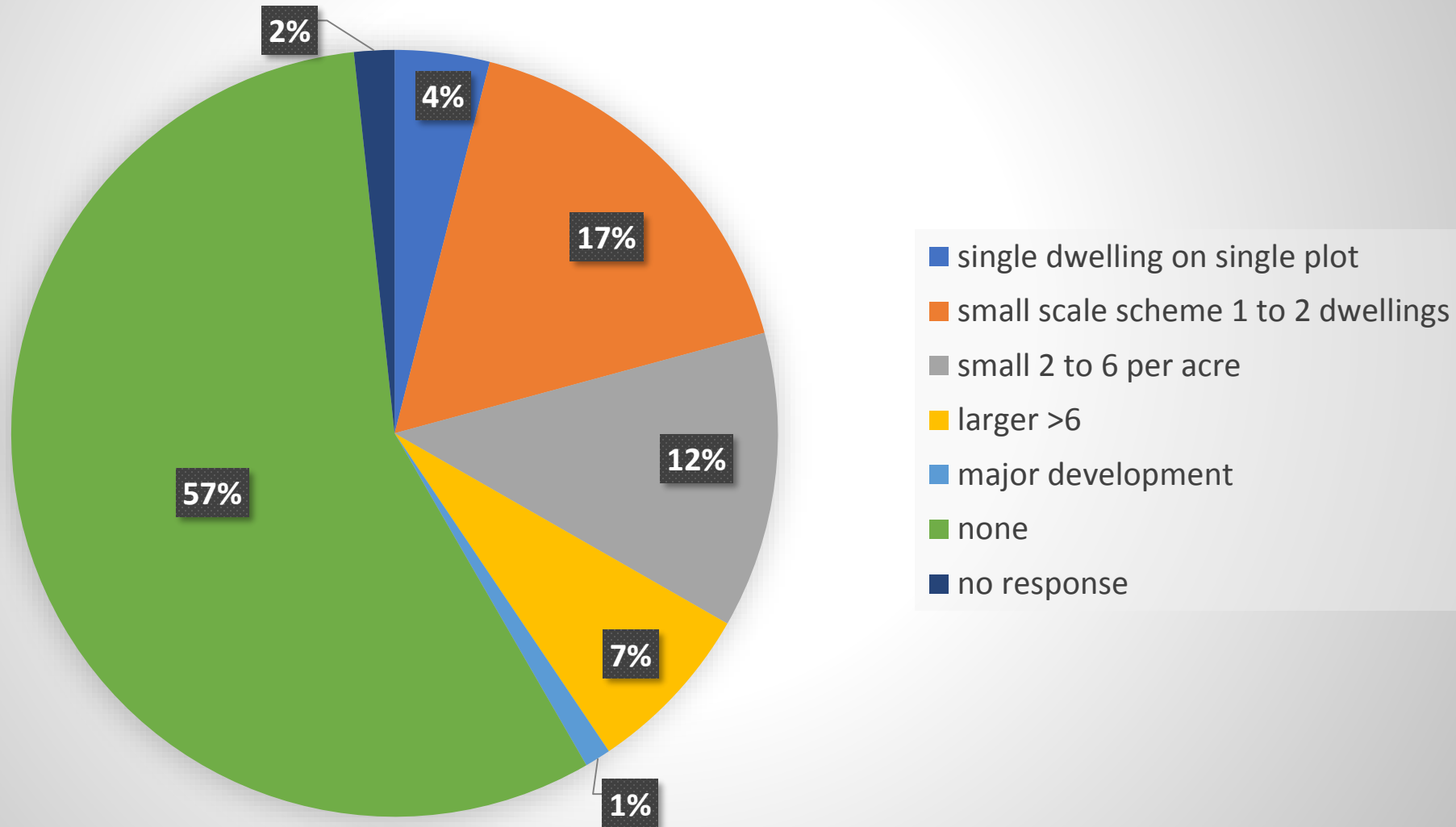

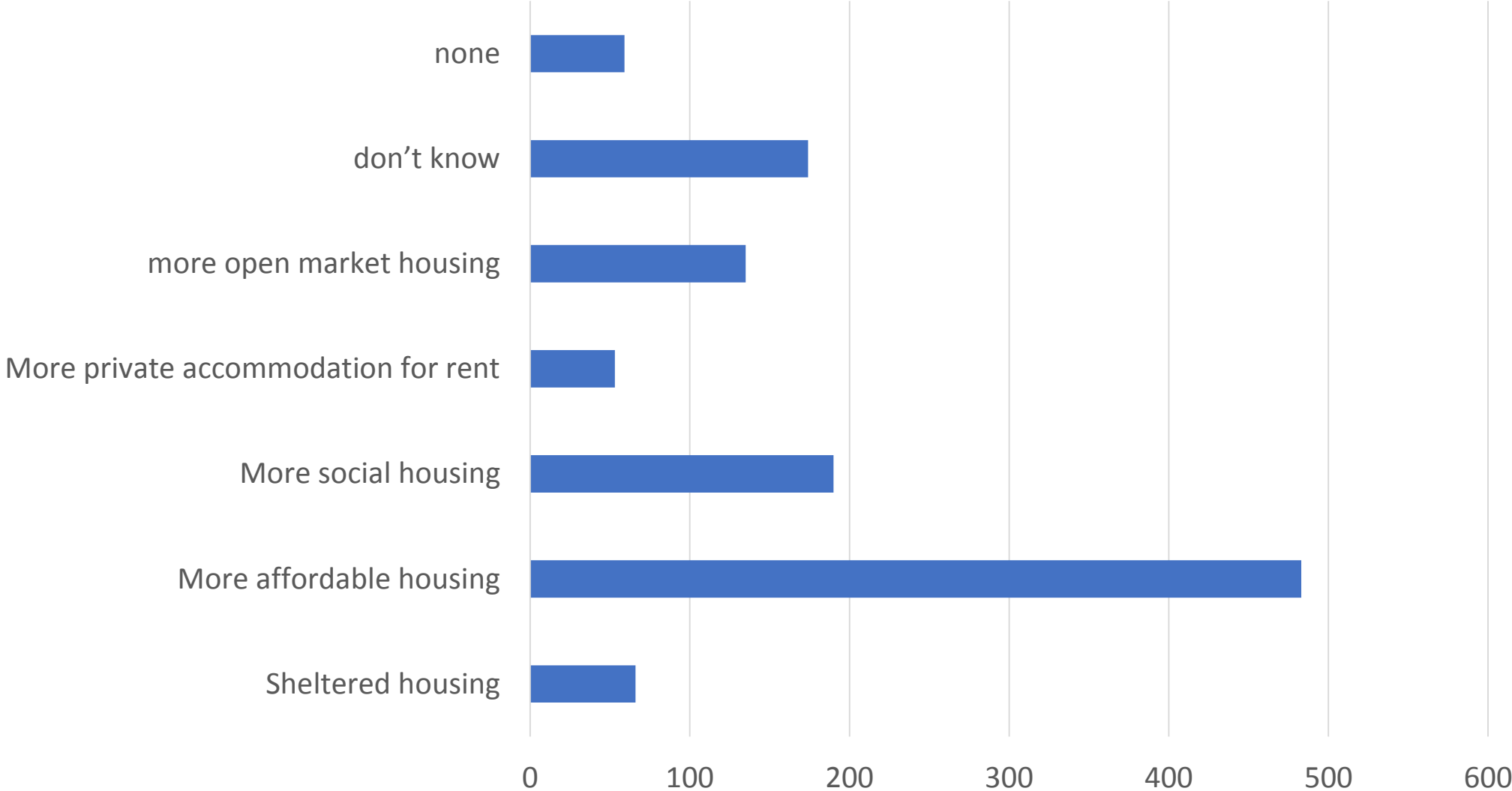

Q5) Thinking about housing development in the Greenbelt, what level of development do you think is acceptable? **573**

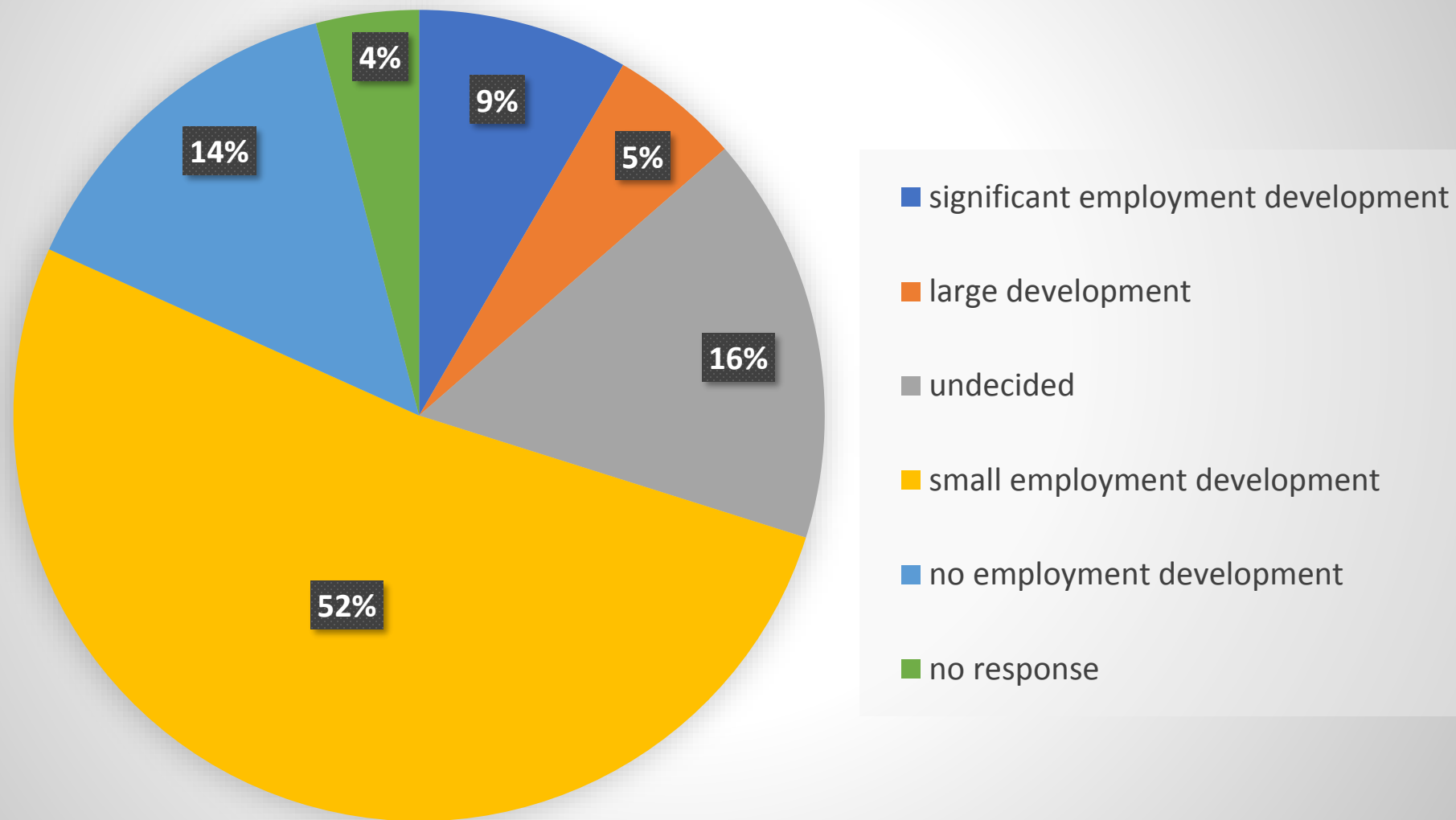

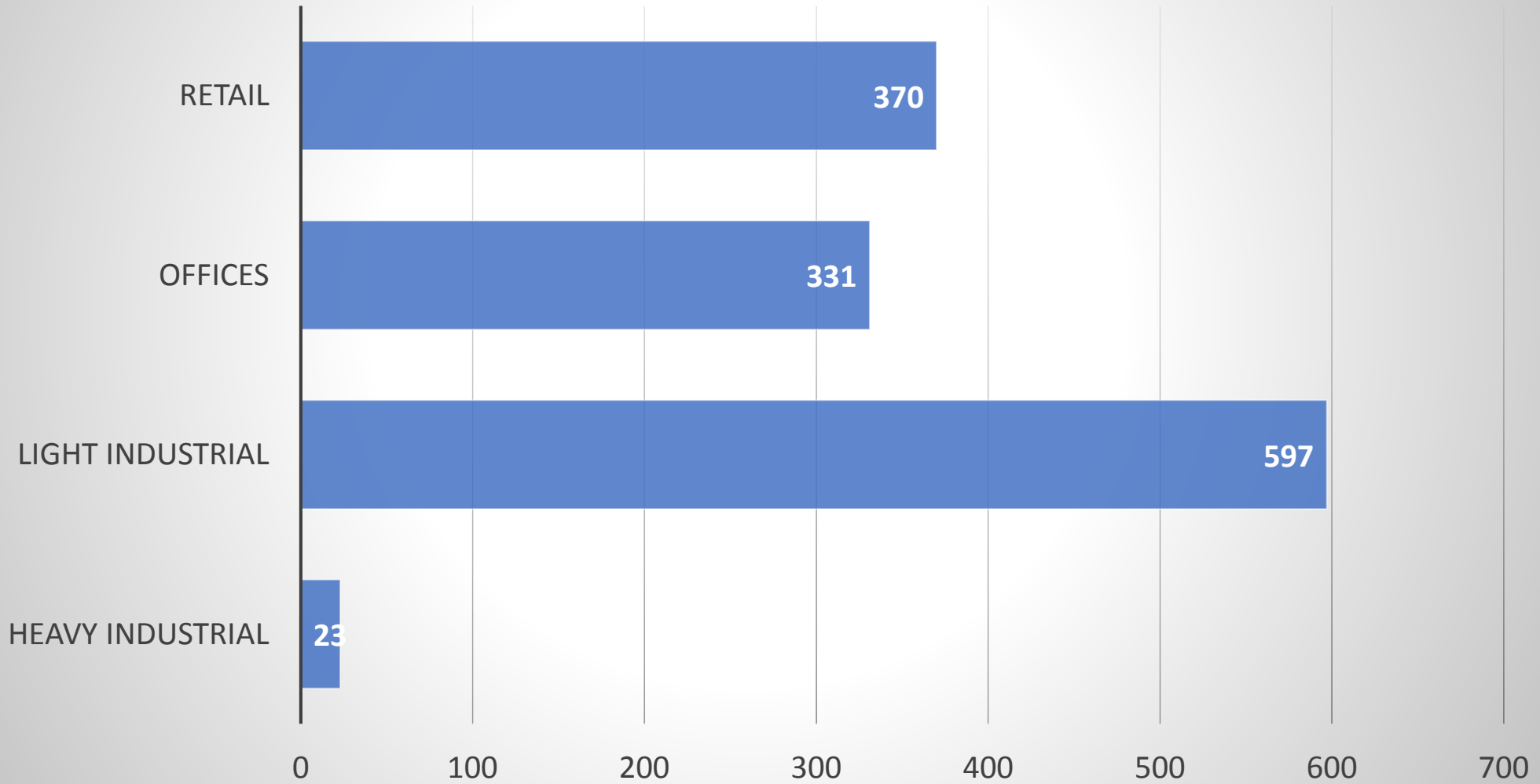
Q6) What kind of housing do you think Bridgnorth and Worfield Parish most need?



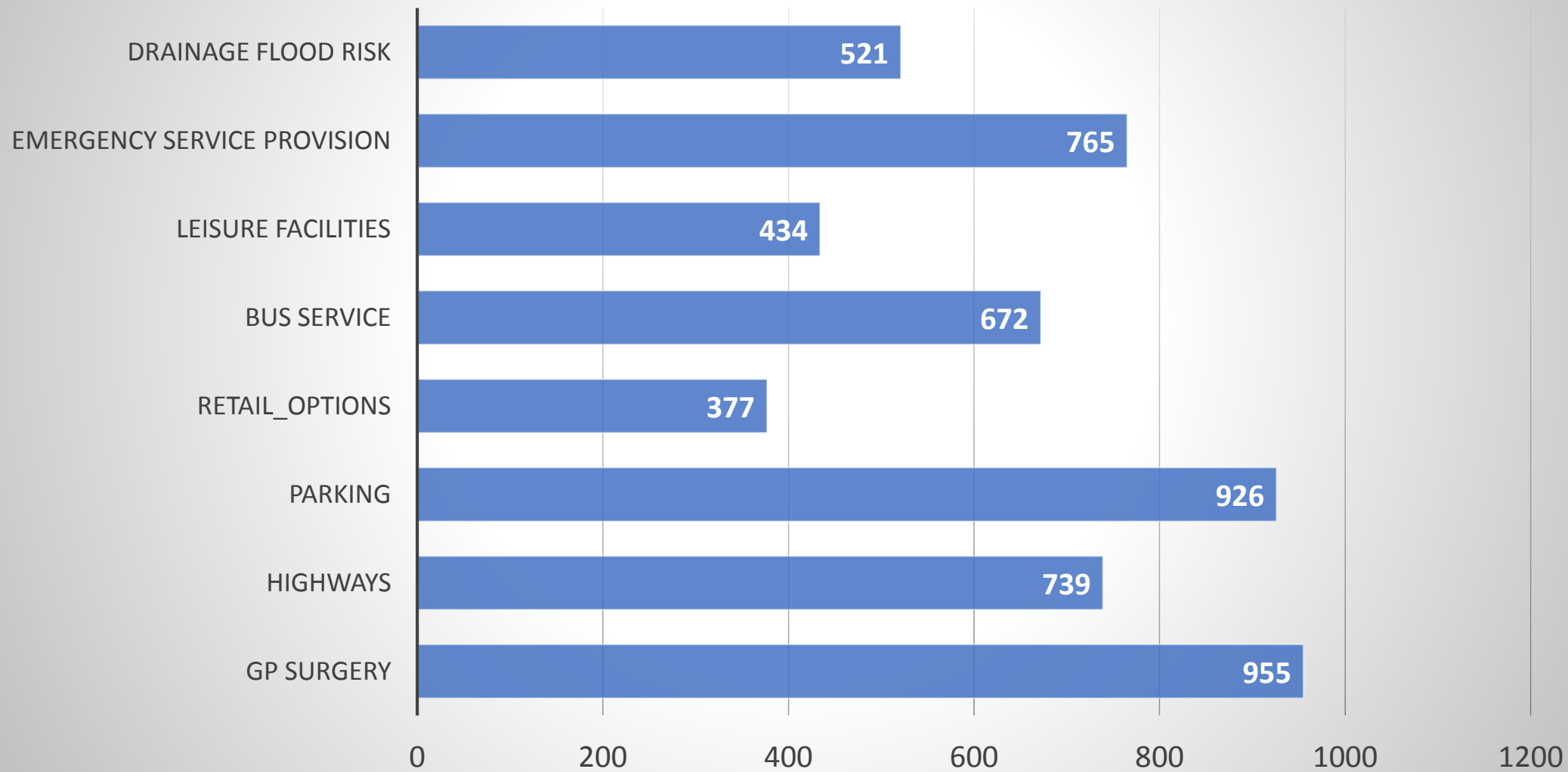
Q7) What development capacity do you feel Bridgnorth needs for employment?



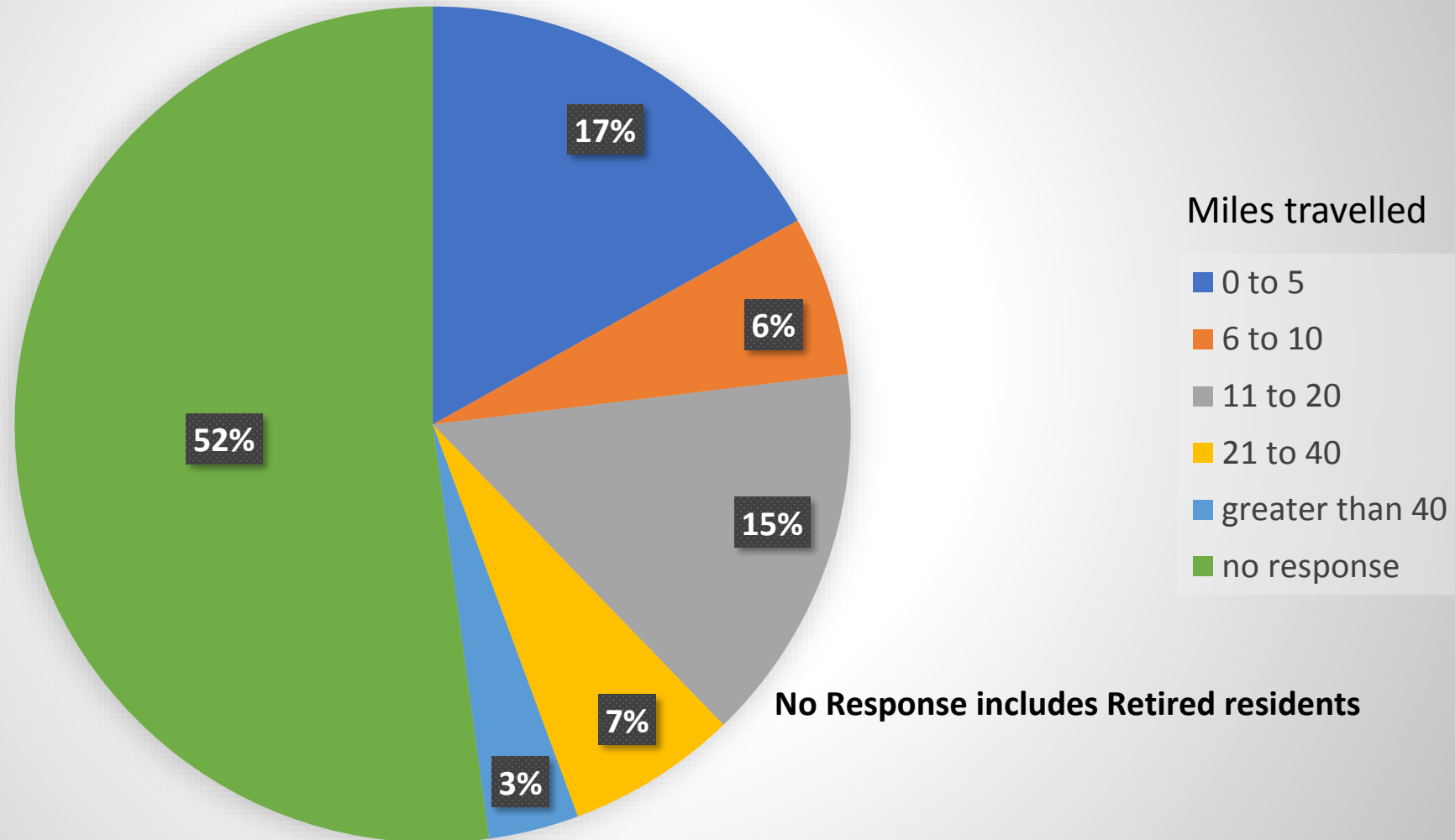
Q8) If employment development was progressed, what type of employment would you prefer to see ?



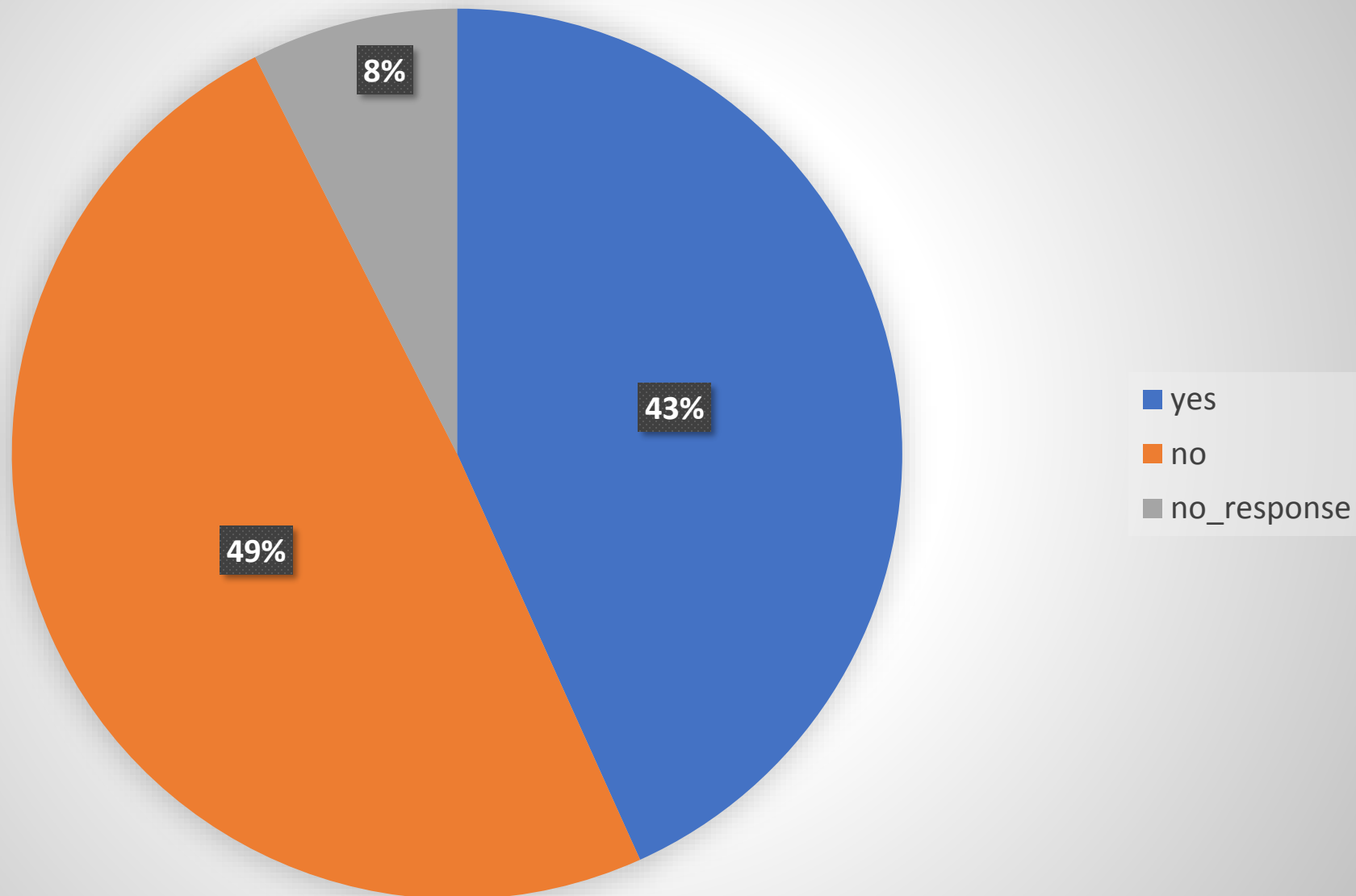
Q9) Which aspects of Bridgnorth do you view as being insufficient to withstand future development?



Q10) Do you commute from Bridgnorth to work, if yes, typically what distance is your daily commute one way?



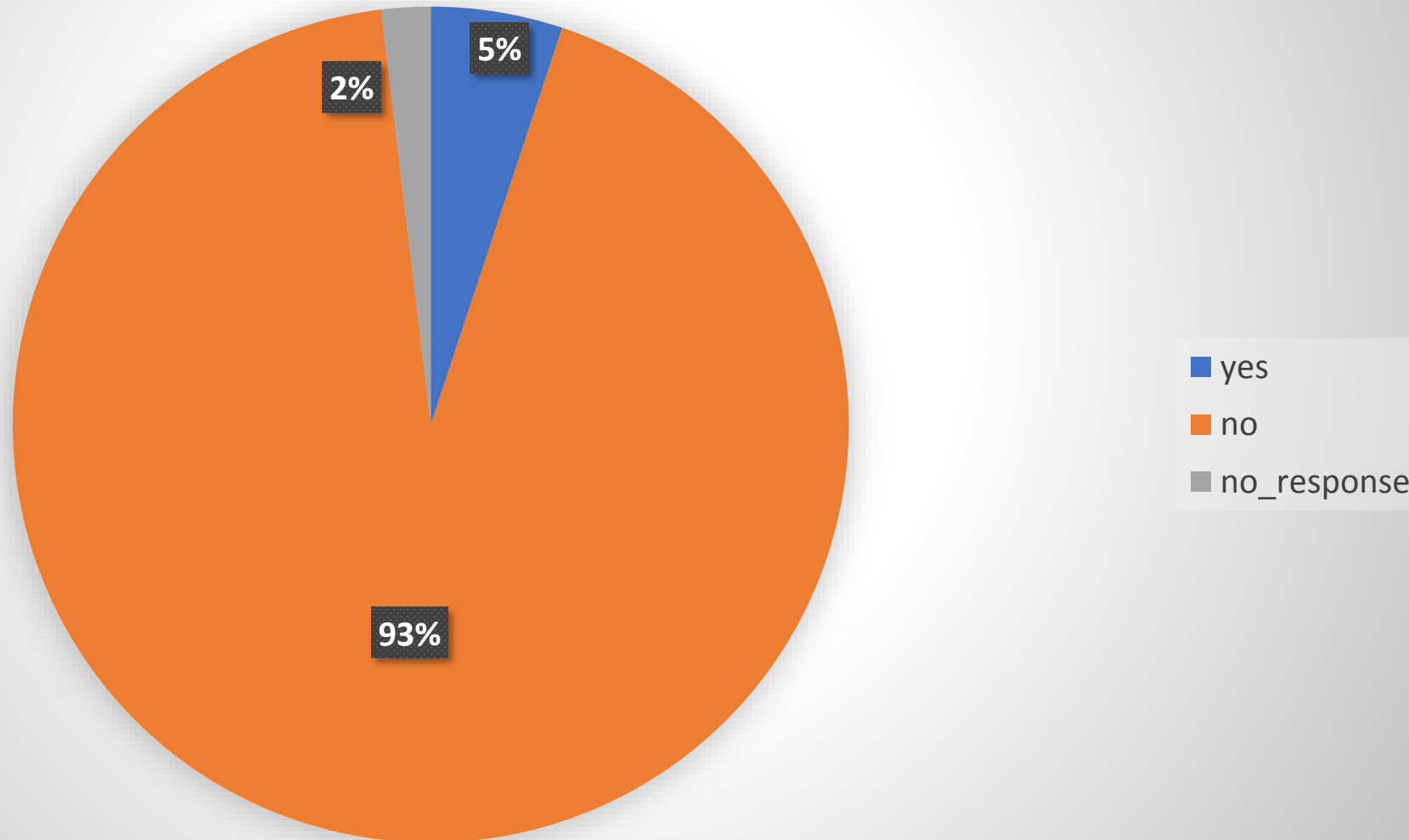

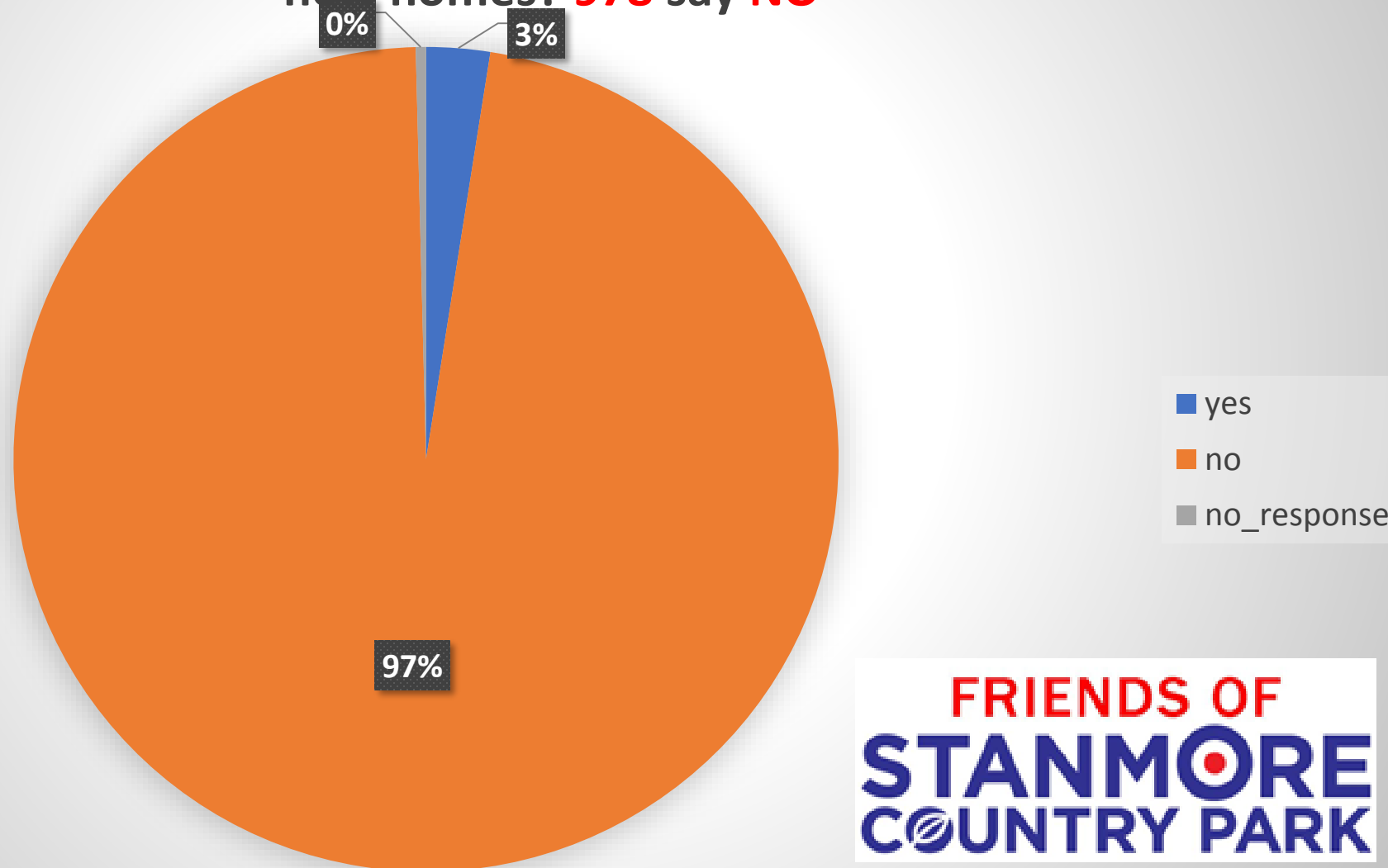

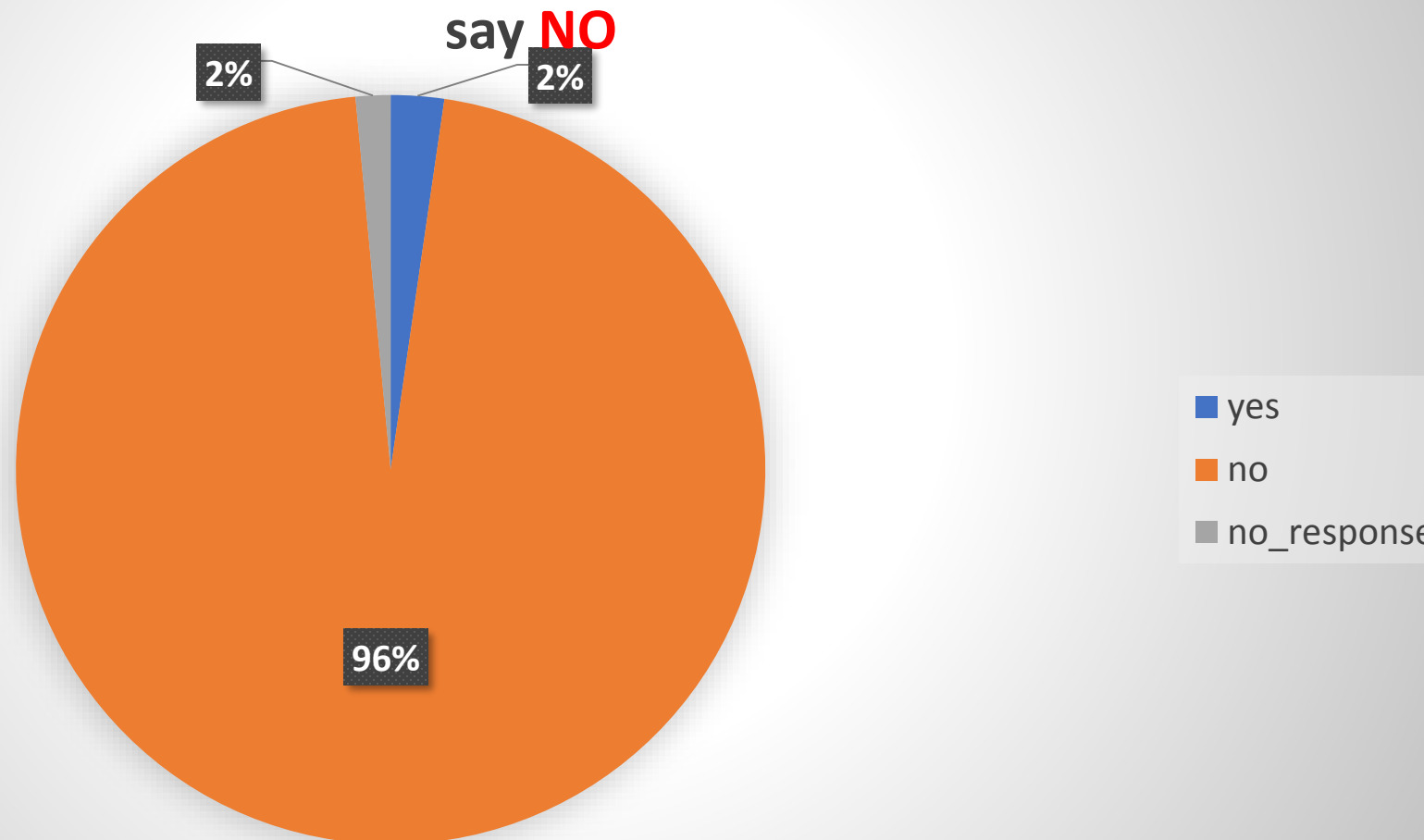

Q14) DO you agree with Shropshire Council's decision to consider accetpting West Midlands overspill housing? **968**

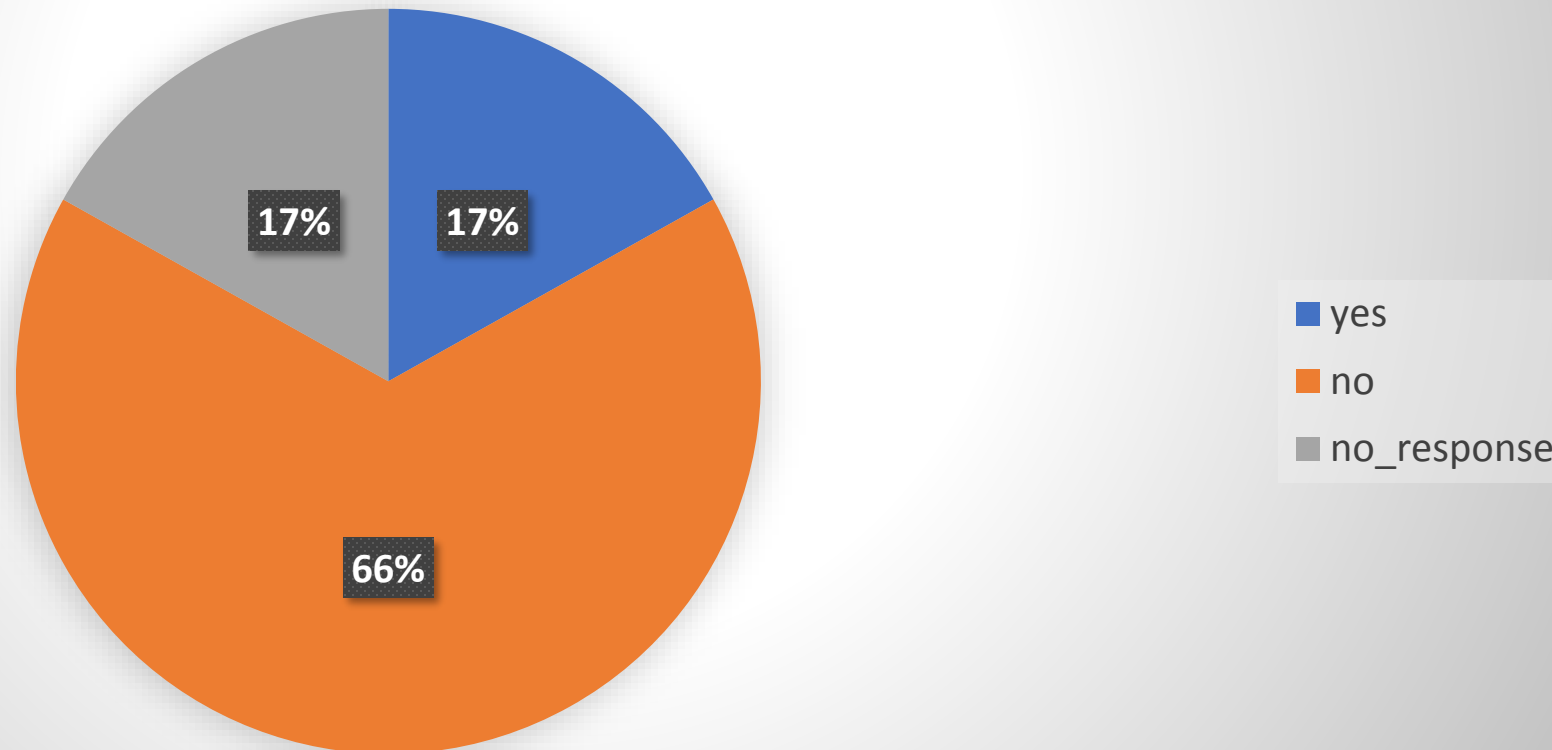

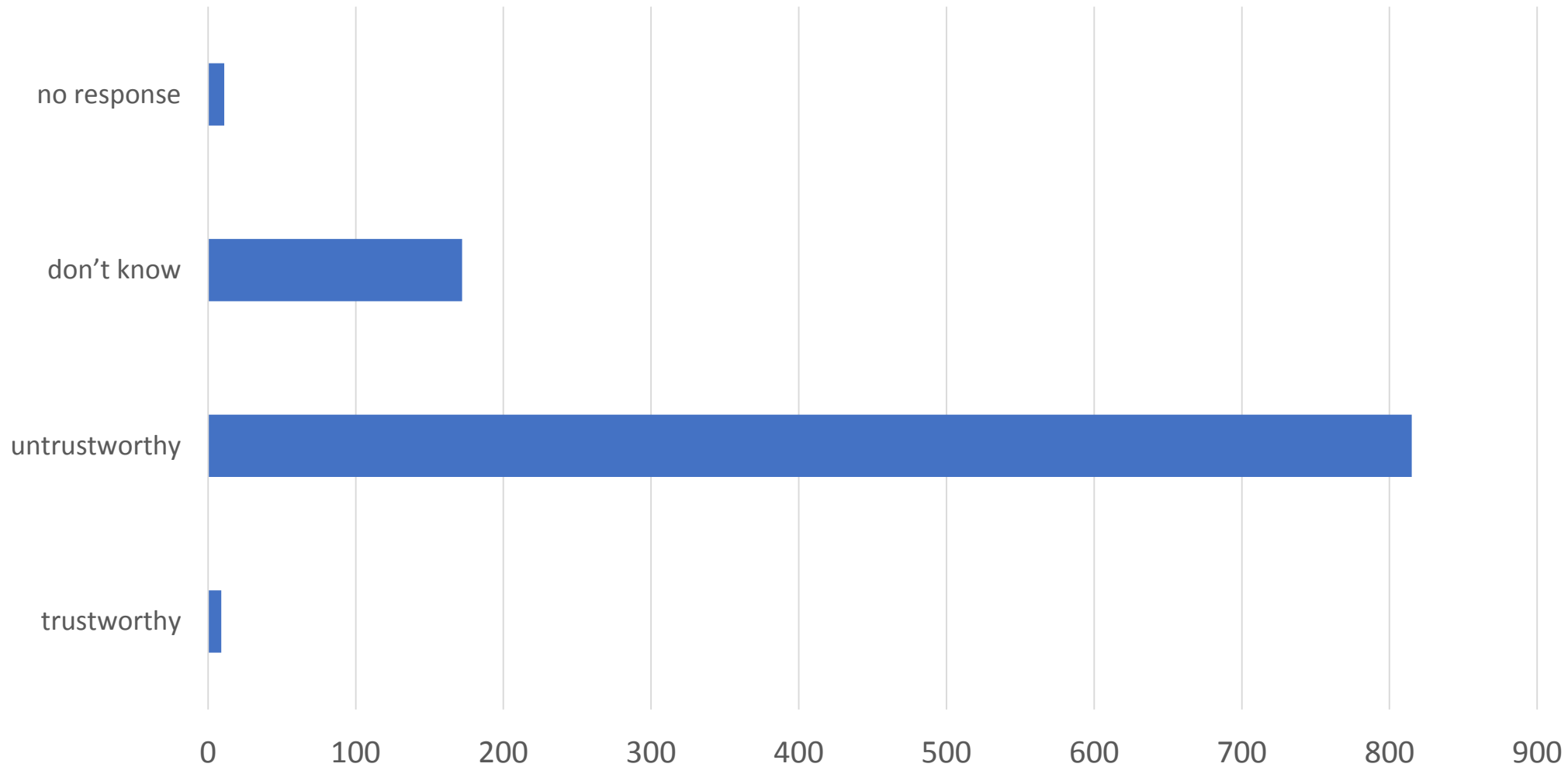

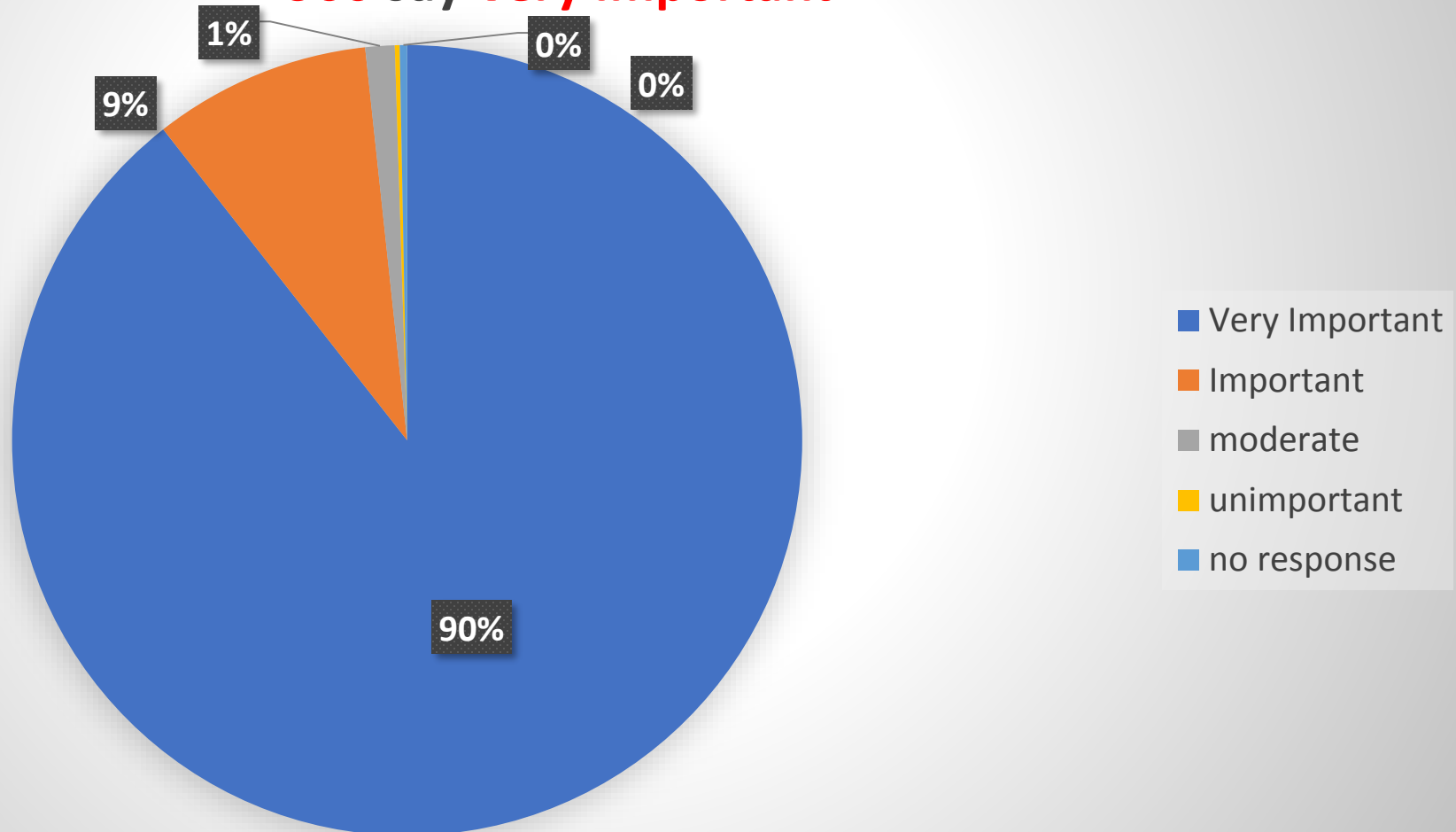
Q16) How trustworthy do you feel Shropshire Council is when it comes to consulting with and listening to local residents about these proposals? **81% Untrustworthy**



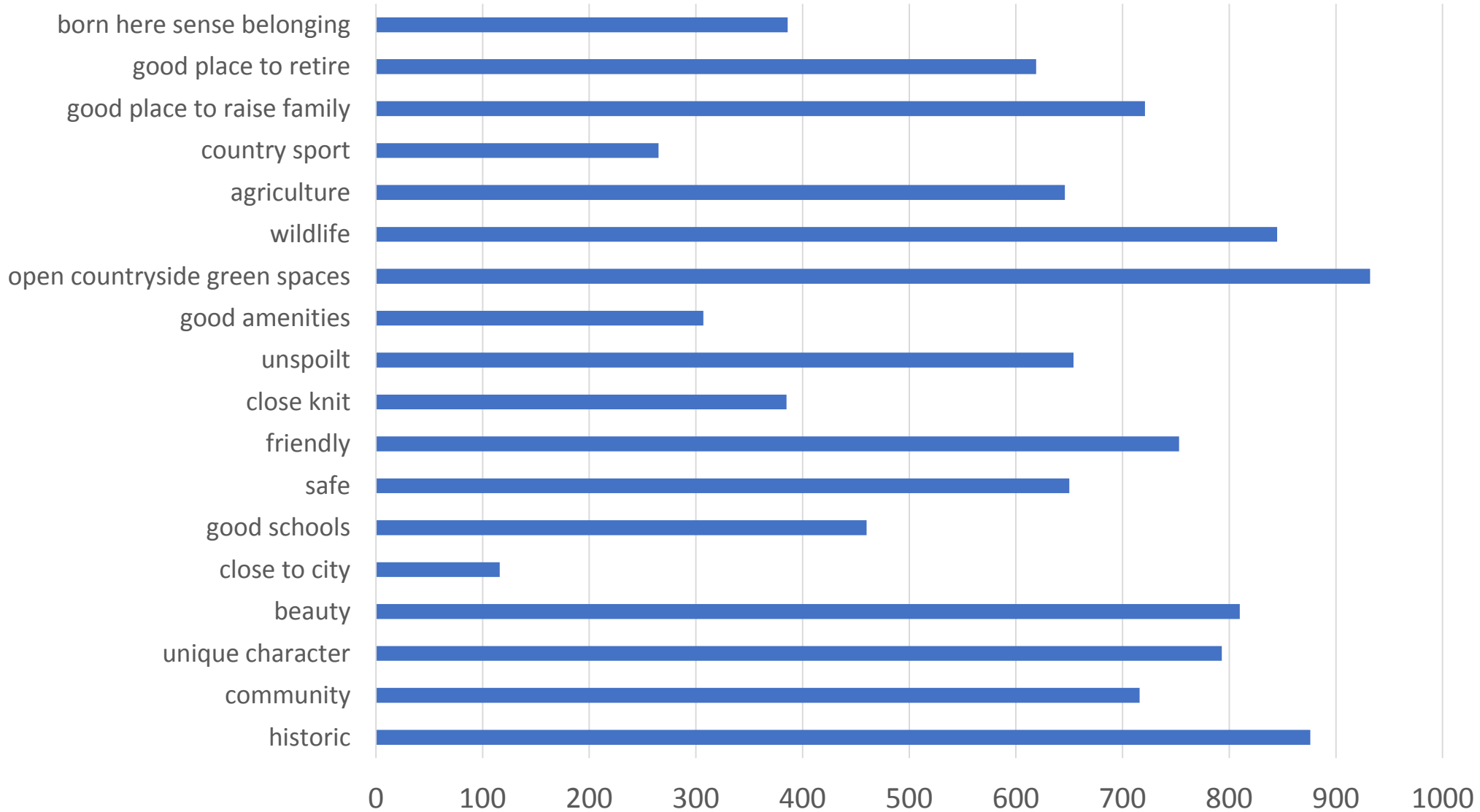


Q17) How important to you are the trees, wild plants, birds and animals in and around Bridgnorth/Stanmore/Worfield Parish?

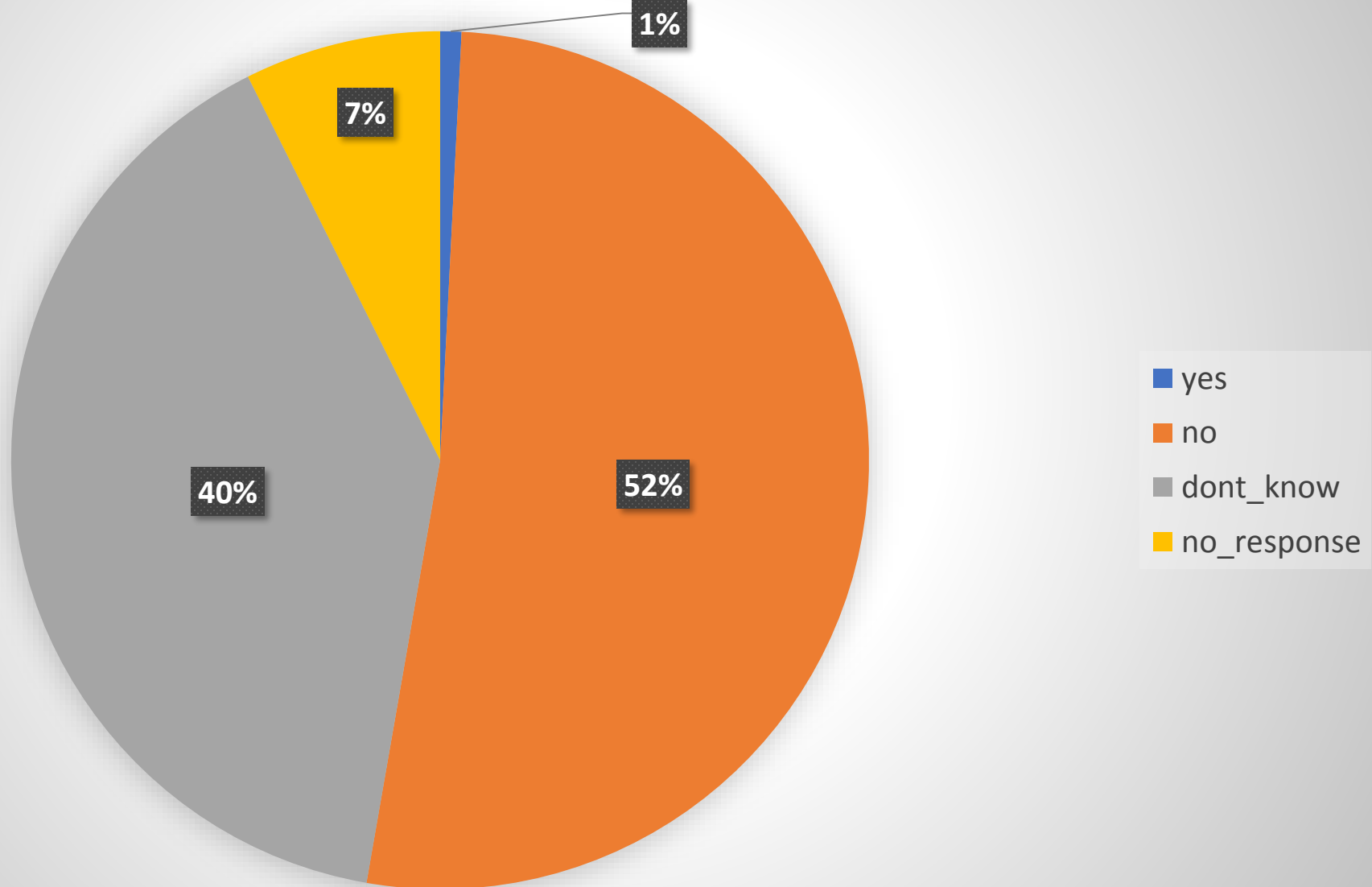

Q18) What do you appreciate most about living in Bridgnorth, Worfield Parish or the surrounding area?

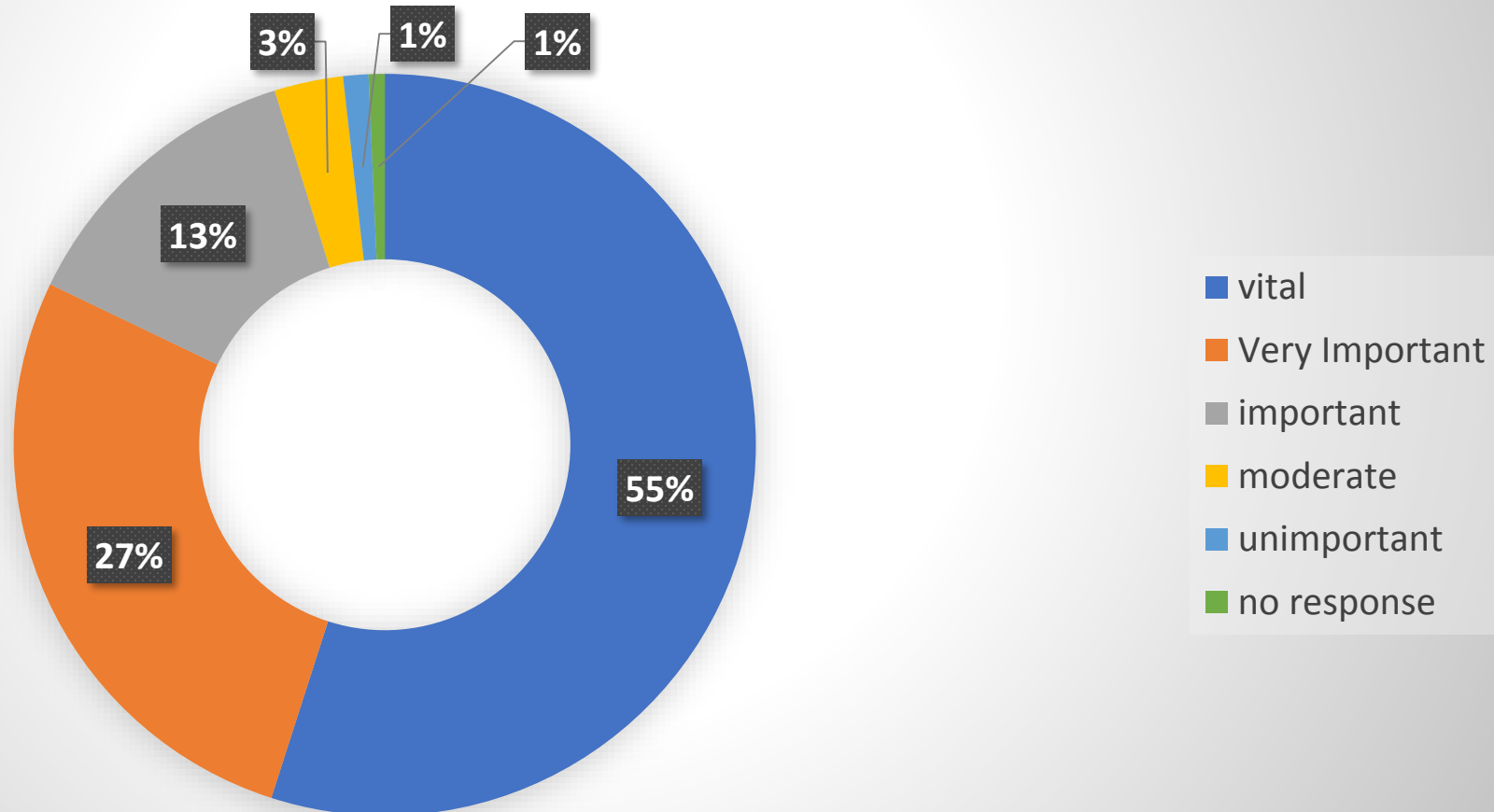


Q19) Do you agree with Shropshire Council's plan for the whole county?



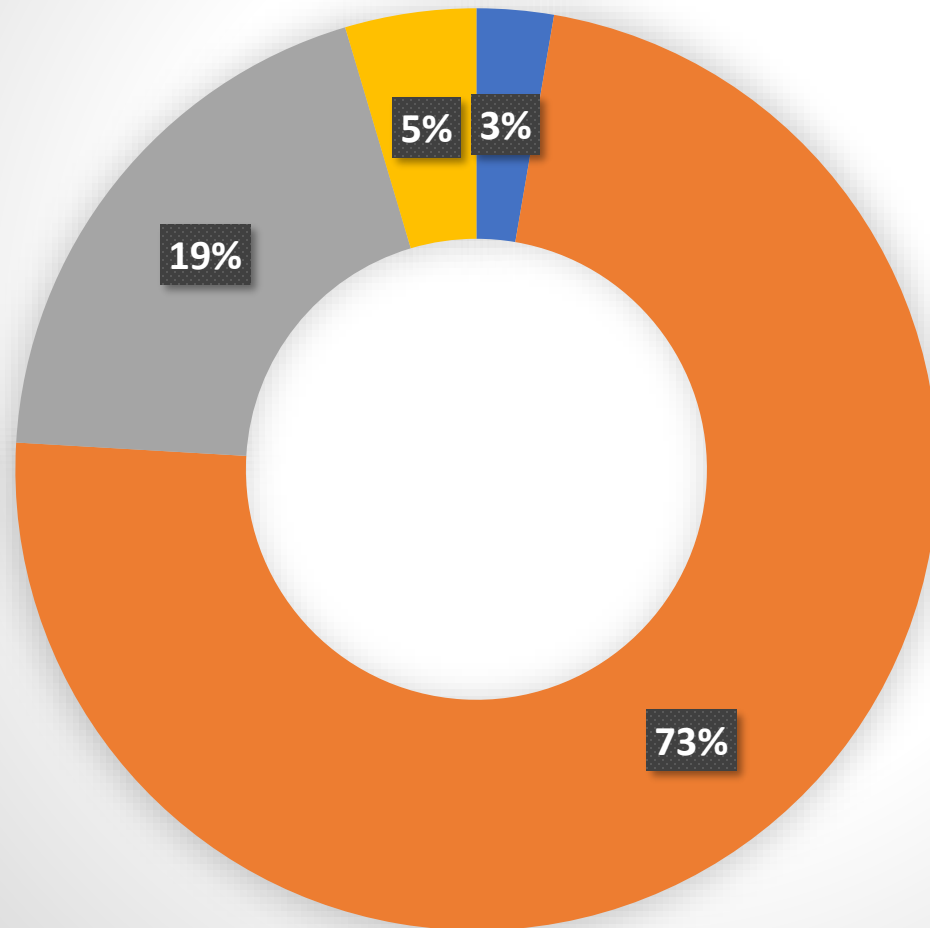
Q20) When considering development, how important do you think reducing carbon emissions and environmental sustainability is?

Preferred Sites Consultation 29 Nov to 8 Feb 2019- Feedback



- **268** responses from Bridgnorth. (3600 responses)

- Two petitions with over **1000** signatures.
